



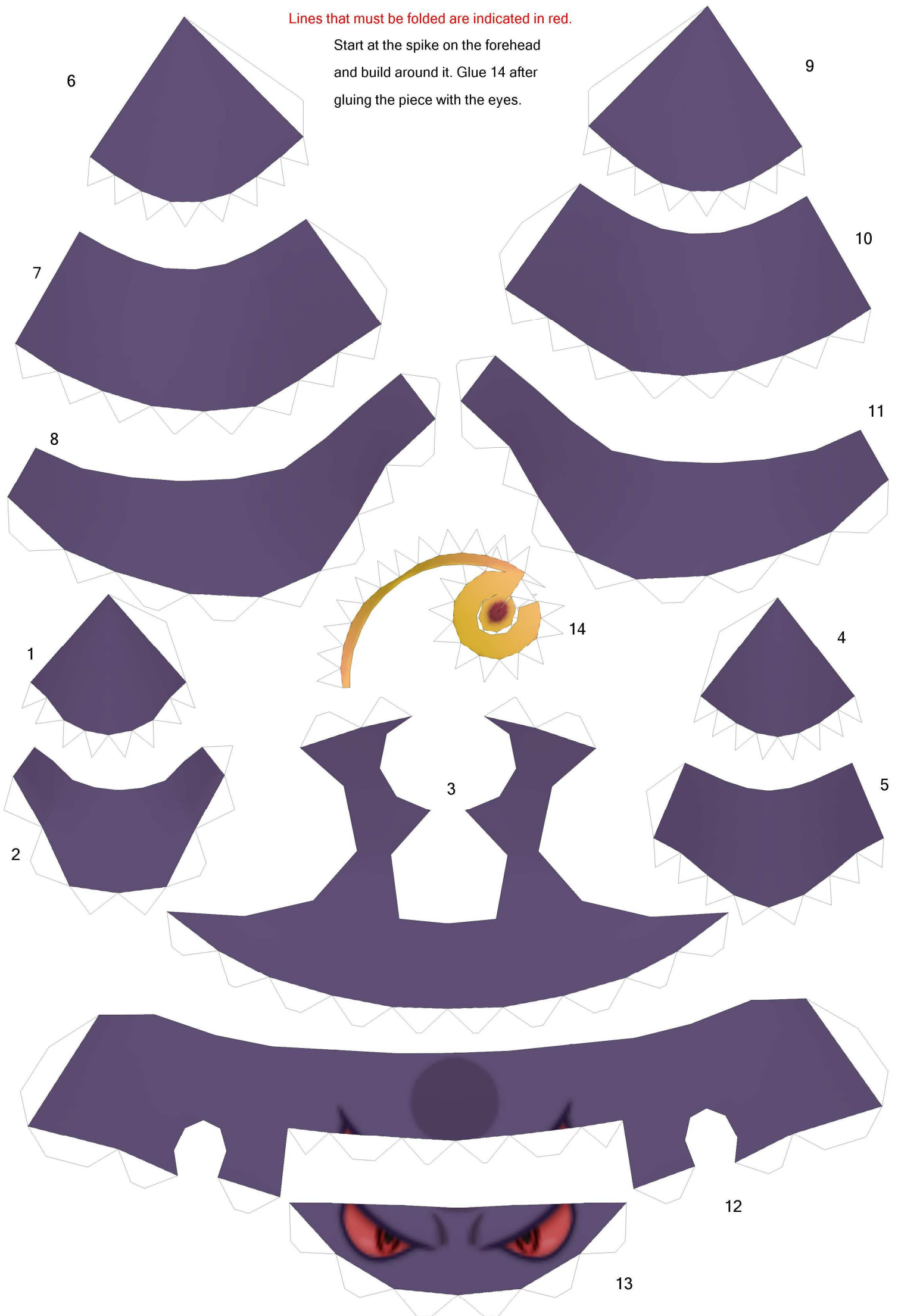

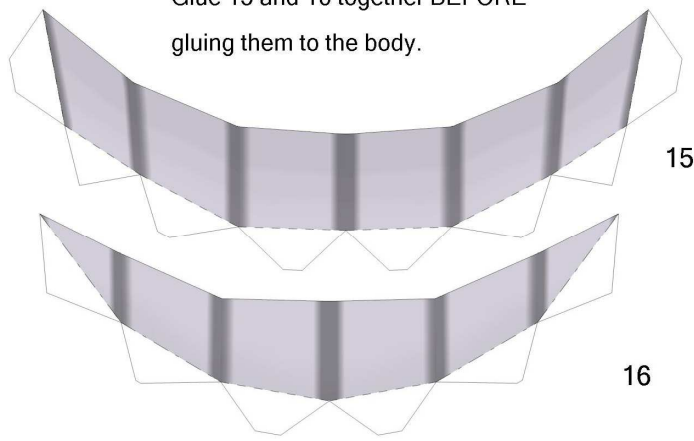

gluing the piece with the eyes.

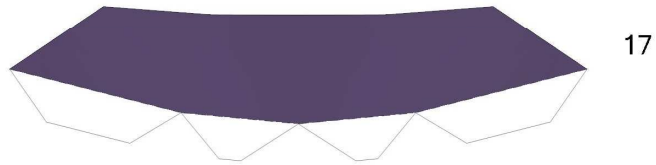


Glue 15 and 16 together BEFORE
gluing them to the body.

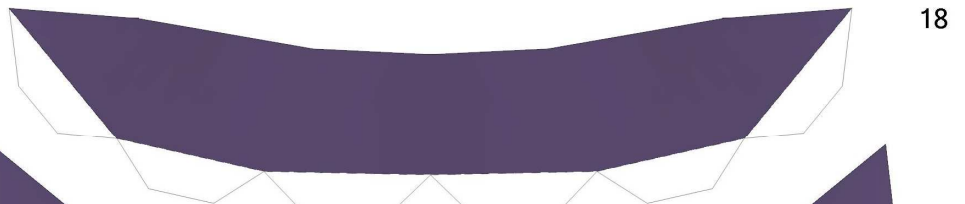

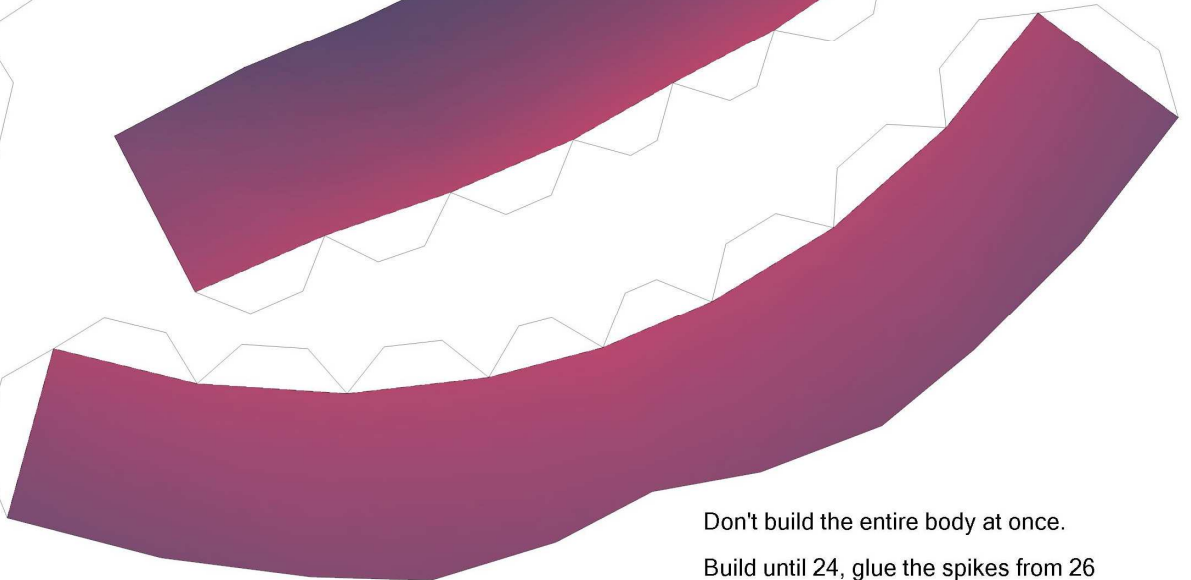
Reinforce the connection between

piece of paper glued inside the body.

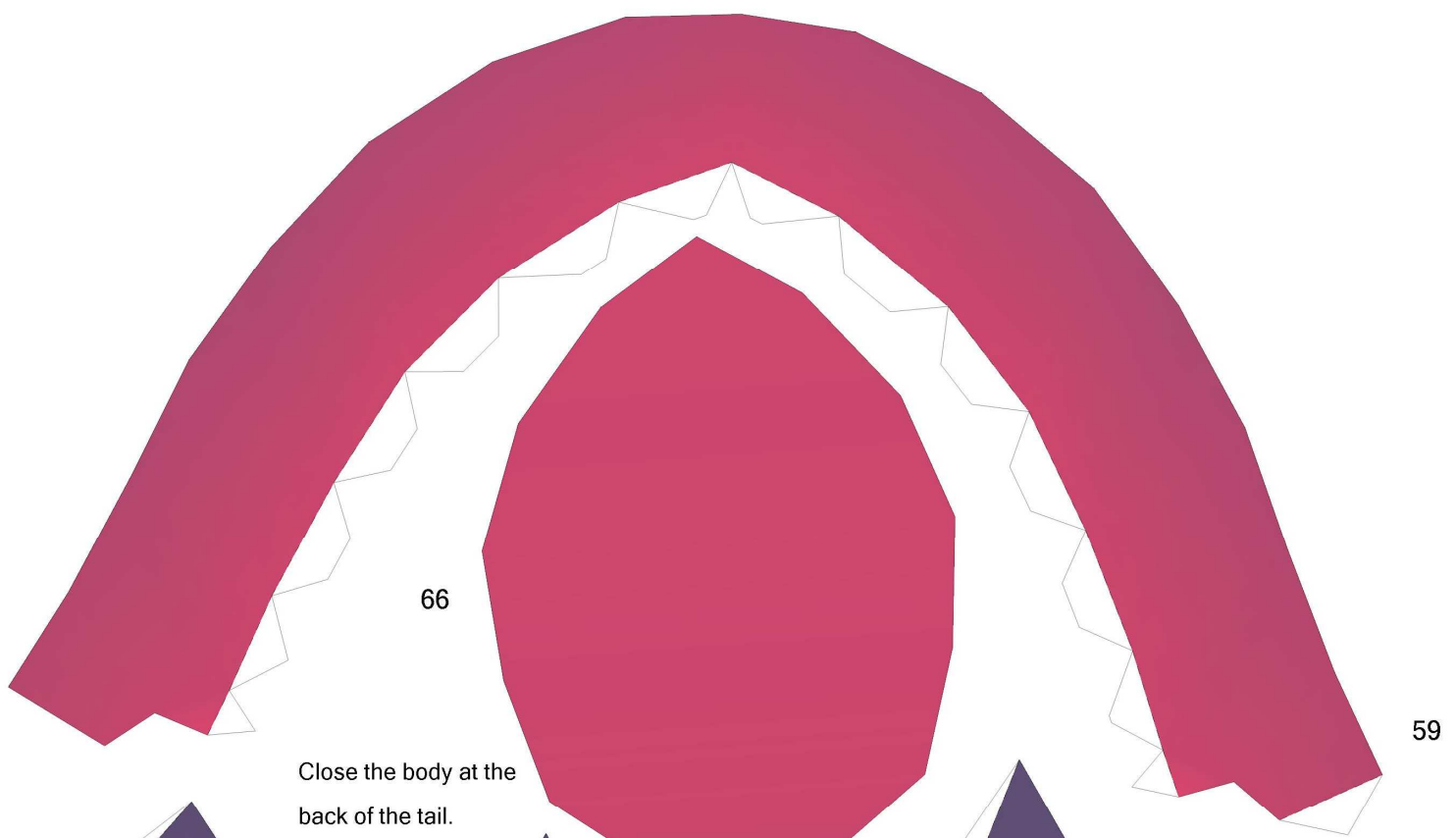

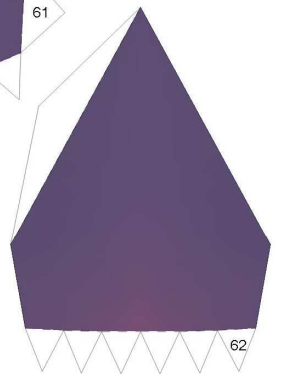
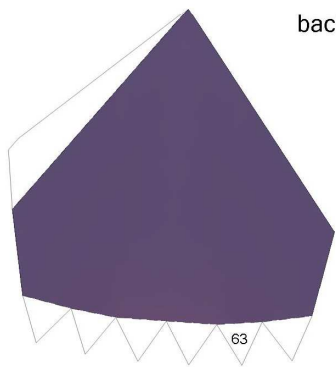

to 50 and only after build the rest of the body.

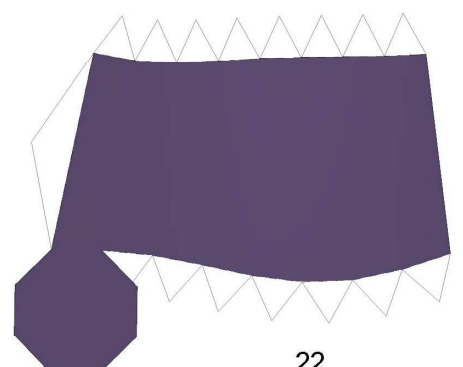
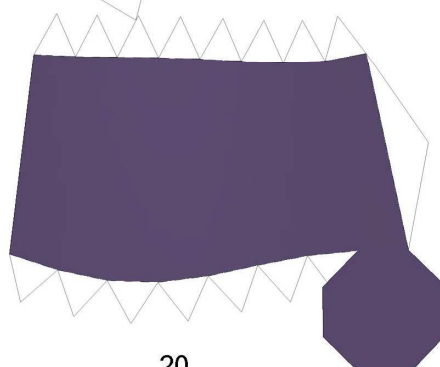
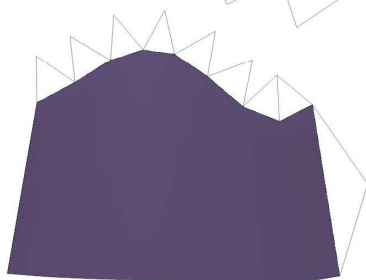
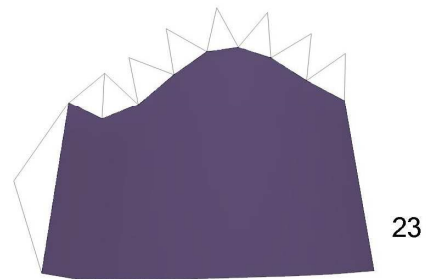




Close the body at the back of the tail.

glued while the model
is still open so you
can apply pressure from
the inside.

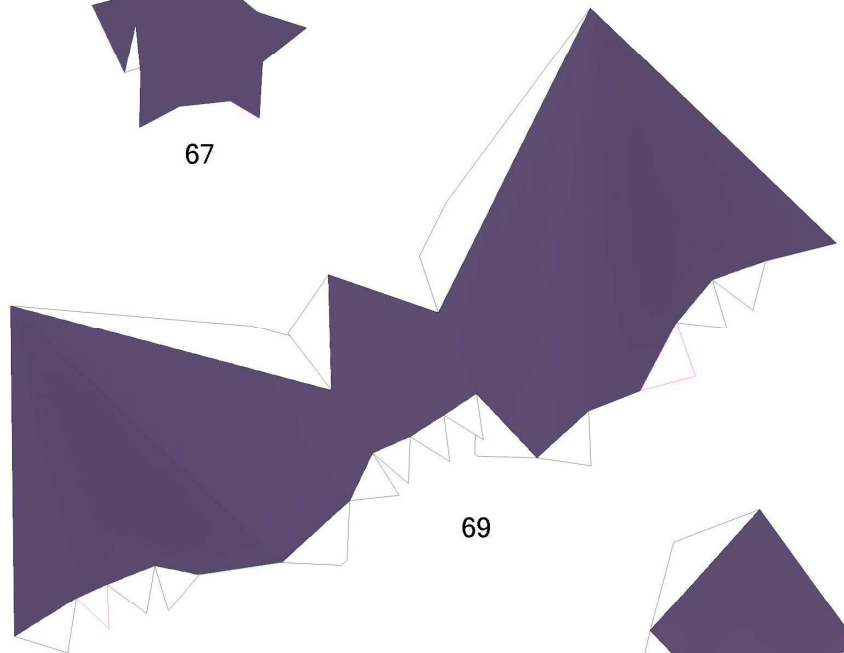
Start at the middle (67 and 77) and build around it, following the numbers. You'll want to round the pieces a bit to give the spikes a better shape.



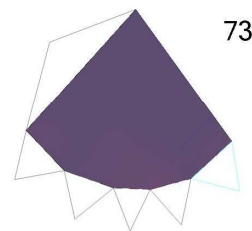
