

Zora armor Link

Every Zelda game has a water themed dungeon, requiring Link to find a way to be able to stay underwater for a longer period of time before he can enter it. Over the series, the aquatic Zora race created a number of items to help Link do just that.

In earlier games, simple Zora Flippers would allow Link to breathe underwater, in Ocarina of Time the Zora Tunic did the same thing, in Majora's Mask the Zora Mask allowed Link to become a Zora himself, but in Twilight Princess, Link relies on magical clothing again to be able to breathe underwater.

Link acquires the Zora armor from Queen Rutela's spirit as a gift after escorting her sick son to Kakariko Village. Using a Water Bomb and the Zora armor, Link can gain access to Lakebed Temple at the bottom of Lake Hylia to continue his quest to save the kingdom of Hyrule...
